I would like to clear up the confusion with the CEU requirement for the 2010 license renewal. Last year in 2009 when you renewed your license you were required to have 1.5 or 15 hours of continuing education credits. You were able to use any credits that you had received in the preceding years of 2008, 2007, or 2006 up to 36 months. The 2009 renewal period was the first time that you were required to have continuing education since the board was established, because it was broken down to where you only needed 15 every 3 years, which is the 5 every year. This past year the state informed us that we could not accept the 15 credits every three years, we were told to assign 5 credits per year starting this year 2010 instead of the 15 every 3 years. So if you do not have any other Continuing education credits other than the ones that you were required to use last year you will need 5 by September 2010.

For those of you who have not gotten any more Continuing education credits other than those that were required last year the Association is holding a convention at the Sandestin Golf & Beach Resort. This will be from July 8-11 2010. They are now having an early bird registration from now until June 25th in the amount of \$250.00 which will offer 15 credits that you can use for 2010, 2011 and 2012 renewal for licensure.
